INTERESTING FACTS ABOUT ROCKY CREEK

The school was designed and constructed using Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) strategies that are geared toward energy savings, water efficiency, improved indoor environmental quality and stewardship of resources and sensitivity to their impacts.

A rocky creek originates in the area of the school's site. Inside the building, there is a 25,000-square foot artistic rendering of the surrounding landscape. Nature comes indoors with the free form image of a meandering blue stream running through the corridors, brightened with recycled glass and mirror aggregates. Centered in the commons area is a grand compass.
